**ROCKLAND** – March 9, 2010 – The City of Clarence-Rockland invites its residents to turn off the lights on March 27<sup>th</sup>, from 8:30 pm to 9:30 pm for Earth Hour.

Earth Hour is an initiative of the World Wildlife Fund – Australia. This global event promotes energy conservation and sends a global message about working together to tackle climate change.

The City of Clarence-Rockland will also participate in this symbolic event. At precisely 8:30 pm, the lights at City hall, located on Laurier Street in Rockland, will be shut for one hour. For security reasons however, a total black-out of municipal buildings is impossible.
