Activity Descriptions

Baby Tales: Come and have fun with your baby during a story time with nursery rhymes and songs.

Busy Feet: Come with your child to participate in a program that encourages physical activity through movement and dance. Please bring water and comfortable shoes.

Circle of Care: Are you looking for a group of parents to talk with? Come meet other parents to discuss various topics of interest and concern.

Fitness Strolling: This activity promotes walking and takes place outdoors. Children must be in a stroller or a baby carrier. Participants should dress appropriately for the weather and bring water.
